### Secretary of State to Reopen Three Facilities to Process CDL Written and Skills Tests;

In recent weeks, MTA has requested the Illinois Secretary of State's Office to allow at least limited access for drivers to take their CDL written and skills tests. Many of these drivers have been in limbo for over a month and companies that had trained these drivers were unable to put them to work.

In response, the Secretary of State will open THREE facilities beginning next week for CDL licensing only. This includes: CDL Written Tests, Pre-Trip Testing and Road Testing. The following facilities are available:
