Due to the increase in COVID-19 cases statewide, my office recently announced that all Secretary of State Driver Services facilities will not be conducting in-person transactions from Jan. 3, through Jan. 17.

Given the impact the two-week closure of facilities will have on the trucking industry, I have directed my staff to implement an emergency rule change, effective immediately, to extend expiration dates for commercial driver's licenses (CDLs) and commercial learner's permits (CLPs) to Jan. 31, 2022. This rule change impacts CDLs and CLPs with expiration dates between Nov. 1, 2021, and Jan. 31, 2022.

I thank and commend commercial truck drivers and the trucking industry for their outstanding efforts to overcome the unprecedented challenges caused by the global pandemic and to continue providing over-the-road transportation of goods throughout Illinois and the country.
